

YOU'RE INVITED TO GKR KARATE'S 2023 OKINAWA TRIP

COMMENCES MONDAY 21ST AUGUST 2023

GKR Karate has been organising trips to Karate's homeland every two years since 2001. Originally exclusive to our Senior Instructors, these visits later coincided with some of Japan's National Karate tournaments whereby our top competitors were also invited. Due to the success and popularity of these regular visits, GKR has been making the invitation open to all students since 2016.

Our previous trip (pre-Covid) had over 70 students and involved seminars with a number of prominent Okinawa Masters. For this upcoming trip, we have organized a different collection of Masters to conduct our sessions, and more details will be provided as soon as we have received full confirmation. Stay tuned to our Okinawa Facebook page for more details. Our karate seminars will take place at the Kaikan. This is a very popular venue that hosts many Martial Arts-based events.

WHY WE CONDUCT THESE TRIPS

Okinawa houses countless karate-related historic sites, memorials and the World's only Karate Museum. These trips offer students the opportunity to broaden their overall knowledge whilst immersing themselves in the culture and customs of karate's true birthplace.

KARATE FESTIVAL ADD ON

We have intentionally started our itinerary on the 21st of August, allowing anyone who wishes to arrive in Okinawa early the ability to join in the Budo no Bugei Karate festival.

All GKR students are allowed to participate in these seminars which start on August 14 and run through to August 20. These seminars are held at the Kaikan (the same venue as our seminars). For any students keen to participate, please don't hesitate to let us know.

The festival is overseen by 10th Dan Master, Kenyu Chinen. Of interest, Master Chinen will be one of the masters conducting a Seminar for GKR Karate.

SPECIAL NOTES

These trips currently have three 'official' training days (18 hours of training). There are however, ample opportunities to do extra training if you wish. You can contact the Okinawa Karate Information Centre by email (OKIC.okinawa) to arrange these classes prior to landing. Alternatively, you can also organize them while there.

SPECIAL NOTES (Continued)

Okinawa is a series of tiny Islands and each is its own version of Tropical Paradise. While a number of these islands can be reached by ferry (or even car, across a bridge), most domestic airlines offer very cheap airfares to the islands further away. August is summer in Okinawa and a great time to explore.

For most people visiting Japan/Okinawa for the first time, Tokyo is generally on their list of places to see. Your flights to Okinawa will come via Tokyo so if visiting there excites you, then be sure to organize a stop-over prior to, or after your Okinawa leg.

If you plan to explore Okinawa's mainland (beaches, waterfalls, tourist attractions etc), hiring a car is very easy. However, you will need an International Driver's license. These can be quickly organized within in your country.
